## CONSUMER DEBT OR HOUSING ISSUE?

- Have you received a notice from a creditor?
- Do you have a judgment against you?
- Is a creditor attempting to put a judgment against you?
- Are your wages being garnished for a debt?
- Have you received a notice of non-payment for your current residence?
- Have you received a notice to vacate because your lease expired?
- Is your current or former landlord suing you for damages?
- Have you received a notice of a small claims suit?

## WHAT IS CLOSING THE GAP?

Closing the Gap connects low-income consumers and tenants to a volunteer advocate using innovative technology to address their legal needs.

We will give you legal advice, information, and/or a referral to a volunteer attorney that will help prepare you with the document you need for court.

Volunteers are private lawyers, law graduates, or law school students who voluntarily accept cases from Legal Aid free of charge. Eligibility for a referral to our program is determined in the same way it is for all Legal Aid services.

## WHO WE ARE:

We are a law firm for low-income people. We provide assistance to low-income households in civil cases.

Our service is free. There is no cost for any of the services we provide.

We believe that everyone has the right to equal justice regardless of the ability to pay.

We will help you secure, protect, and preserve your legal rights.

Our staff are highly skilled, committed individuals who are experts in the practice of poverty law.

We are not a government agency.
